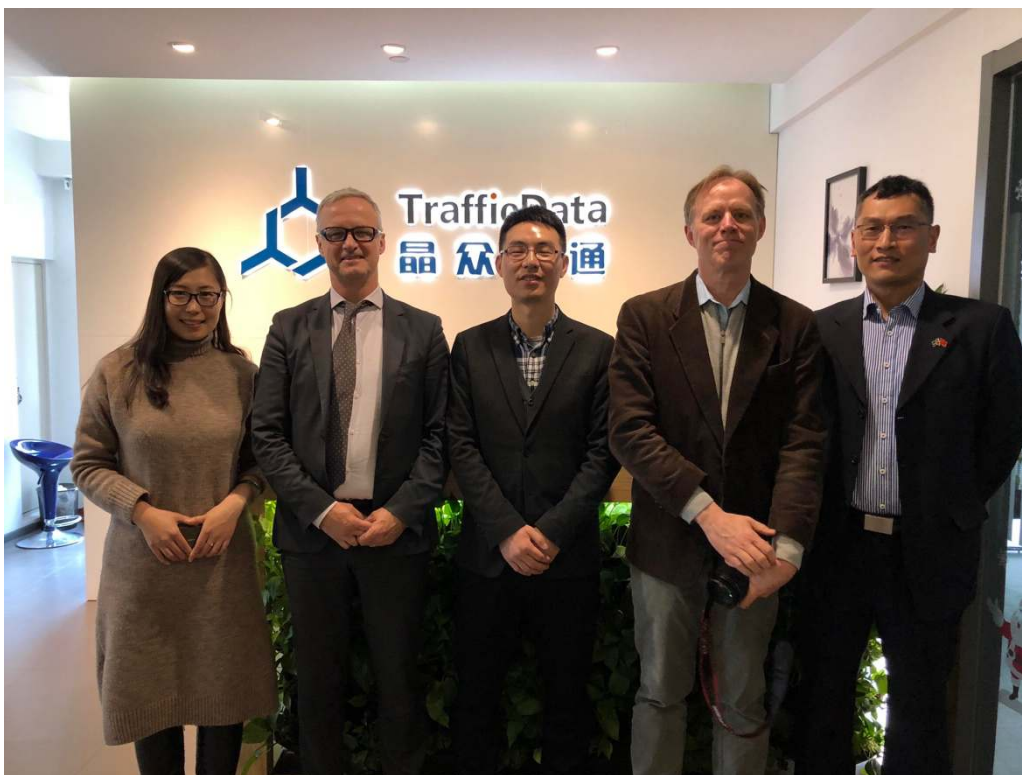


Itinerary from visit to Beijing, China

China – budding entrepreneurs catalyze sustainable development

Day one and two

Visit to the CHINA EV 100 conference in Beijing. EV 1900 is the most prestigious organisation working on electro mobility.

Day three

Visit to NeVS office, and their new factory in Tjianing. Meeting for an interview with Kaj Johan Tjiang, Chairman of NEVS. NEVS has one of 18 licenses to mass manufacture EV's.

Day four

Visit to SITECH where we meet Mr Ding Dong, and Mr Chen Ping, Vice president at BJEV.

Day five

Meeting with delegation at Chinese Academy of Urban Planning and Design under its Director Yuzin Zhao. In the Afternoon Traffic Data, meeting with its director Chester Che.

Day six

Visit to Tsinghua University, Department of Automotive Engineering in Education. Visit to Professors Hewu Wang and Yang Fuyan.

Visit to Bella Zou, International Expansions Manager at Mobike, and later to the Swedish Embassy for a meeting with the Ambassador Anna Lindstedt.

Day seven

Meeting with Mr Chen Maomin, international Director EV100.
